Your child may be suffering from Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). The NYU Child Study Center is currently evaluating children between the ages of 8 and 13 to determine if they qualify to participate in a research study and receive expert care at **no cost**.

ADHD can cause difficulty with behavior, academic performance and peer relationships. The highly qualified staff at NYU Child Study Center can help.

This study focuses on the problems that many children who suffer from ADHD have with organizational skills, such as managing their time, managing materials needed for school work and activities at home, and being able to plan activities.

Children enrolled in the study will be taking Concerta®, a medication commonly used for patients with ADHD. Children who have received previous treatment with stimulant medication will not be eligible to participate.
