Your child may be suffering from Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). ADHD can cause difficulty with behavior, academic performance and peer relationships. Children with ADHD often have difficulties in school such as attending to classroom activities, interacting with peers and adults, following classroom rules, and completing work assignments.

The NYU Child Study Center is currently evaluating children between the ages of 6 and 12 to determine if they qualify to participate in a research study and receive study-related care at no cost. If eligible, your child will receive medical and psychiatric evaluations and medication to treat ADHD.
